

Rainfall Harvesting Rebate Application

Program Description

The city of Horseshoe Bay's Rainfall Harvesting Rebate promotes water conservation by encouraging residents and businesses with City water to collect rainwater for non-potable use. The rebate is a one-time offer covering the purchase factory-made components for rain collection and storage systems. The rebate does not cover labor costs. The maximum rebate is \$250 per account. The program is open to any Horseshoe Bay water customer, including those outside the city limits.

Requirements

- The system must comply with the City's Rainfall Harvesting Ordinance and covenants and restrictions of the customer's property owner association.
- Rebates apply only to factory-made rainfall harvesting system components.
- The city limits participation to one-time per property.
- Receipts must be itemized with charges for parts separated from labor costs.
- The owner must submit receipts and the application to the city within 90 days of the final purchases of rain harvesting system components.
- A rebate will not be allowed until installation is complete, and the owner must allow an inspection of the system after installation.
