

Rainwater Harvesting Rebate Application

This rebate is for the purchase and installation of rainwater harvesting systems. Rainwater harvesting is a great way to lower irrigation costs and stress on Pflugerville's water system. By installing a rainwater harvesting system today, you are helping conserve water for our Pfuture.

Program Guidelines

Eligibility:

- Must be a single-family residential customer
- Must be property owner or utility account holder
- Pflugerville Water Customers can only apply once a year for program benefits but can buy multiple barrels per application.
- Applicant must be a direct City of Pflugerville water customer in good standing. (Customers within Districts where the City of Pflugerville operates are not eligible)
- Rainwater collected will only be used for non-potable purposes and not connected to the City's water supply
- An itemized receipt must be submitted with the application within 30-days of installation. Receipt must include date, vender name and address, amount paid, and capacity of the barrel.

Rebate Details:

Maximum rebate amount is \$600 per water account and does not cover the cost of installation

- Rebate is \$0.50 per gallon of storage capacity, not to exceed barrel purchase price
- Rebate is 50% of the purchase price of pad material, overflow, first flush, and pump to distribute the water.
- Rebate is 25% of the cost of gutters, as part of a rainwater collection project. Does not include gutters not connected to rainwater harvesting tank.
- All rainwater collection/harvesting equipment is exempt from sales tax per Section 151.355 of the Texas Tax Code. To claim this exemption, purchaser must furnish a Tax Exemption Application Form 01-339 to the supplier at the time of purchase. The form is within this packet and available on the Texas Secretary of State's Office website at: https://comptroller.texas.gov/taxes/exempt/forms/

Barrel Requirements:

- Must be a new system or an expansion of an existing system. Used or self-made barrels are not eligible
- Must be dark-colored or have an internal liner to prevent sunlight from penetrating the tank
- Must have screens on opening to prevent debris, insects, or animals from entering the barrel
- Must have a pipe to direct the overflow water away from the base to prevent erosion and localized flooding
- If barrel is made of galvanized metal or wood, it must have an interior liner to prevent rusting or rotting
- Barrels must be level on a pad site made of concrete, gravel, or sand



How to Apply

- 1. Read program guidelines
- 2. Once the project is completed, submit the below application and itemized receipt within 30 days of installation.
- 3. A staff member will contact you to set up a final inspection.
- 4. A rebate check will be mailed to you within 4-6 weeks after application and final inspection have been completed
